

#### Before you begin...

✓ Ensure that you have sufficient space to work and allow at least ONE HOUR for assembly, particularly if you have never built a unit before. We recommend two-person assembly.

✓ <u>Always</u> use a rubber mallet for assembly and **NEVER** a metal hammer. Please note: **force is required!** The components are designed to fit tightly together so that they don't wobble or break apart, so a light tap will **NOT** locate the parts sufficiently.

✓ We recommend wearing gloves when assembling.

# **Assembly instructions**

**STEP 1:** Attach the five feet [1] onto the uprights [2] & [5] **NOTE:** The two front uprights [5] on this unit have different feet to the other three uprights and are formed from protective strips (supplied).

**STEP 2:** Join the three corner uprights [2] at the lower-most shelf level using two rear width beams [3] (see illustration on the right).


To add a width beam, strike its lugs firmly down into the "keyholes" of the uprights using a rubber mallet. Force is required. **NOTE: the lugs do not need to go completely to the bottom of the keyholes.** Pinch the side beam and upright together using thumb and forefinger directly between the lugs to ensure they are located before hammering.


**STEP 3:** Now add the two obtuse-angled front uprights [5] to the corner uprights using depth beams [4]


**STEP 4:** Join the two obtuse-angled front uprights [5] together by adding a front beam [6]

**STEP 5:** Place a shelf [7] onto the constructed shelf level, and then repeat the above steps working upwards to complete your unit (see illustration on the right).
